

Release Notes FirstSpirit 4.2.454

Notes on the hotfix version

This version 4.2.454 is a hotfix for FirstSpirit version 4.2.453, to correct an updating problem in the Package pool (see "Package pool: updating packages in the subscription").

The hotfix version contains an additional two bug-fixes for the display of data record dependencies and in Content Highlighting.

The Release Notes for FirstSpirit Version 4.2.453 – apart from the section "Using Content Highlighting and the CMS_GROUP design element" – apply without restriction and should be read through carefully before using the hotfix version.

Package pool: Updating packages in the subscription

In CorporateContent (previously PackagePool) and in the package management, packages in the subscription can be manually or automatically updated. This is usually necessary if a new package version as been created.

Unfortunately, problems can occur during the updating of subscriptions with FirstSpirit Version 4.2.453.

A data loss cannot occur as a result of the updating problem!

The problems during the updating of subscriptions can be prevented in FirstSpirit Version 4.2.453, by restarting the FirstSpirit System Service "PackageManager" (System and project configuration / Server / Properties / Modules / System / PackageManager) before updating the subscription and after generating the new package version.

This hotfix version contains a bug-fix for the updating problem.

Use of hotfix version 4.2.454 is therefore strongly recommended!

Using Content Highlighting and the CMS_GROUP design element

In the Release Notes for FirstSpirit-Version 4.2.453 it says that in several rare cases, when using the Content Highlighting in conjunction with the CMS_GROUP design element, it is possible that the selected element is not surrounded with a border.

The hotfix version contains a bugfix for this problem, so that this item no longer has to be taken into account.
